Playful Lessons

When your child is leaping through puddles or wielding an imaginary wand, she's not just having a good time; she's setting the stage for learning. Check out the educational benefits of some common preschool activities.

Sorting-Grouping buttons by color or stocking the shelves of a pretend supermarket by food category helps kids learn to recognize patterns, a key component of mathematics.

Water Play-When they drop ice cubes into a tub of warm water, pour liquids from one container to another, or play with the stream from a hose of a faucet, children are figuring out flow and motion, two basic physics concepts.

Make-Believe- Imaginary play enhances language skills and vocabulary, while pretending to be a cashier can instill early addition and subtraction skills.
