Hold the Soda...

Even **one** soda a day may negatively affect kid's behavior, found a new Columbia University study of close to 3,000 5-year-olds. And the children who drank **four or more** carbonated beverages a day were twice as likely to destroy others' belongings and get into fights. It's not clear exactly what it is about soda that may be associated with behavior, but study author Shakira Suglia, Sc.D., points to the fact that many sodas contain synthetic food coloring, which has been linked to hyperactivity, and some contain caffeine, which can make anyone jittery.
